

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular (or special) session this date January 9, 1939 that the following funds be appropriated.

\$700 from Individual Indian Moneys Account of the Fort Apache Indian Agency for the following purposes:

Per diem of \$4.00 for Council Members when attending regular monthly meetings and such special meetings as may be called during the year and such other expenses as may be necessary in the transaction of tribal matters during the remainder of this year.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1939, duly adopted, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 1 Article 6 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is hereby submitted to the Secretary of the Interior for his approval as required by Section 1 Article 6, Paragraph d & e above, and will be effective when approved by him.
