

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular (or special) session this date February 3, 1939 that the following funds be appropriated.

That the Secretary of the Interior approve and request Congress to appropriate \$25,000 of the Tribal Funds now in the Treasury of the United States to the credit of the White Mountain Fort Apache Indians to assist in the construction and installation of a pipe line six miles long to bring the water supply from Diamond Creek to the School and agency by gravity. This gravity system to take the place of the irrigation and pumping system installed in 1922 in connection with and operated by the Hydro-Electric Plant. All in accordance with designs and plans as compiled and approved by the Irrigation Department and as outlined and justified in letter by the Superintendent which is herewith submitted.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1939 duly adopted, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe consisting of ten members, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 1, Article 6 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is hereby submitted to the Secretary of the Interior for his approval as required by Section 1, Article 6, Paragraph (d) & (e) above, and will be effective when approved by him.
