

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS: The White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation has Tribal Industrial Assistance Funds appropriated by Congress to assist members of the Tribe to become self-supporting and there is no convenient place within approximately one-hundred miles where machinery, seeds, animals, tools and other equipment and supplies necessary for carrying on farming and livestock activities can be purchased:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal Council under authority of its Constitution and By-laws hereby authorize the establishment of a buying and selling enterprise to be operated in accordance with the plan attached hereto and made a part of this resolution, and requests the Secretary of the Interior to make \$20,000 of said Industrial Assistance Funds belonging to the Tribe available for financing the same enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the provision of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect until a certified copy or copies of a duly adopted resolution or resolution rescinding or amending the resolution, as the case may be, shall have been furnished to the Secretary of the Interior.
