

A RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session on this date May 15, 1939 that:

The Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Alfred N. Hanson for the purpose of cutting and delivering logs amounting to approximately 800,000 bd ft., at a cost of \$6.38 per thousand, delivered at the Agency Saw Mill and all work in connection therewith as stipulated in the advertisement and contract for the purpose of delivering logs to the Fort Apache Agency Saw Mill to be manufactured into lumber for use within the reservation and for commercial sale to other Agencies and private parties as seems justified and as previously carried on in behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1, Article VI, paragraph n of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
