

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe  
in regular session this date August 1, 1939 that:

The pipe line known as Fort Apache Pipe Line, which is to be a gravity water supply from Diamond Creek to bring a greater and better supply to the Schools, Agency and community by gravity and thus substitute the present pumping system for domestic power and irrigation purposes be and the same is hereby approved and encouraged. The tribe, through its Council, has previously recommended and included in the budget for the fiscal year 1941 and appropriation of \$25,000 from Tribal Funds to assist in the cost of this project.

Be it resolved that the Council strongly urge the Indian Office to approve and use its good offices to encourage and construct this project at the earliest practical date as the same is one of the most important beneficial projects that can be constructed for the benefit of the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of August, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (3), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
