

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date August 1, 1939 that:

Effective this date the Superintendent is authorized to deduct 10% from all the royalty payments collected from leases made to him or direct to the Tribe through its governing body as may be provided in all leases now in effect or that may hereafter be contracted. The Treasurer is hereby directed to deposit 10% of all proceeds arising under such leases with the Superintendent, and such deduction or as much thereof as may be needed be expended by the Secretary of the Interior in inspecting mines, examining mineral deposits, and supervising mining operations, accounting, checking, etc. within the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation in accordance with existing law.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of August, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1, Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
