

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
in regular session this date August 1, 1939 that:

The Superintendent is hereby directed to evict and exclude
from the Reservation any and all persons who are not legally
entitled to reside thereon and who through violation of Federal
and Tribal regulations, become a nuisance and menace to the peace
and quiet of the orderly conduct of the reservation. Such eviction
to be approved by the Police Judge and signed by the Chairman of the
Tribal Council in accordance with Article VI, Section 1(c) of the
Constitution and By-laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of August 1939 duly adopted
by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White
Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1
(c), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the
Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
August 23, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
