

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN PESPERVATION

WHEREAS: Mr. D. C. Barnum of Phoenix, Arizona, has made an application for a Mining Lease, covering approximately 240 acres adjoining a lease he already has, dated November 7, 1938, covering an area of 120 acres, for the purpose of developing Asbestos, and where he has shown by his diligence that his intentions to develop these properties so they will yield a revenue for the Tribe are consistent with the intent of the Mining Regulations, Now

THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED: That The Tribal Council approve his lease for 240 acres lying within the Salt River Area of Gila County and adjoining the Western boundary of the D. C. Barnum Lease, dated November 7, 1938, described as being 1800 feet in width, and 6000 ft. in length, in Sec. 6, T 5 N, Range 17E and Section 1, T 5N, R 16E, Sec. 35, T 6N, R 16E, Sec. 35, T 6N, R 16E, Gila County, Arizona, in accordance with the authority vested by Section 1-c, Article 6 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
