

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date August 1, 1939 that:

That the tribal cattle known as the I.D. Tribal Herd and the tribal cattle known as the Old Folks Herd be consolidated and in the future carried on our records and operated as the Old Folks Tribal Herd; and that all proceeds from this herd be deposited in the Treasury of the United States as Individual Indian Money, Fort Apache Indian Agency Old Folks Herd in accordance with Article VI, Section 1-(d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and that so much thereof as may be necessary be annually withdrawn for the operation and support of the herd and for the support of indigent people not able to support themselves. Such funds to be drawn on in accordance with Paragraph (d) and (e) of the above referred to powers of the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of August 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1-(d) and (e) Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified on the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
