

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Petersen and Webb of Pinedale, Arizona, as purchasers, have a timber contract on the North Boundary Timber Unit of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, which expired August 17, 1939, and

WHEREAS, Although the purchasers have paid for and cut 2,500,000 board feet, the estimated stand of the said timber unit, the Unit still contains approximately 500,000 bd ft. of uncut timber, and

WHEREAS, The purchasers have applied for extension of contract for a one-year period, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, in regular session this date September 5, 1939 that the contract covering sale of the timber on the North Boundary Unit be extended to August 17, 1940.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
