

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date September 5, 1939 that:

\$2,000 or so much thereof as may be needed from Individual Indian Moneys of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, deposited to the tribe, be allotted to the Superintendent for salaries and material in making temporary repairs to the reservation road in the Cibecue District from the Stock Station on the south to the junction of Salt Creek Draw and Cibecue Creek on the north. This road is being used as a bus line for the transportation of children attending the day school. Transportation is almost impossible owing to poor condition of the road and bridges and repairs are most urgent before winter sets in. The above expenditures to be in accordance with Article VI, Section 1 (d) and (e) of the Constitution and By-laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was this 5th day of September, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1-(d) and (e) Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 424).
