

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date September 5, 1939 that:

That \$5,000 or so much thereof as may be needed of Individual Indian Money of the Fort Apache Indian Agency deposited to the credit of the Tribe be allotted to the Superintendent for salaries, feed, and other expenses necessary to take care of the Old Folks Tribal Herd for the fiscal year 1939. Above expenditures to be in accordance with Article 6, Section 1, (d) and (e) of the Constitution and By-laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was this 5th day of September 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1-(d) and (e), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 1y of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
