

RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date September 5, 1939 that:

The action taken by Congress, as indicated in Office Circular Letter of August 5, 1939 is understood by the Council, and a sum in the amount of \$1,000 is set aside from Tribal Funds for the emergency suppression and prevention of forest fires on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; that, if an emergency should demand an additional allotment on this Reservation, consideration will be given by the Council at that time.

The foregoing resolution was this 5th day of September, 1939 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d) & (e) Article VI of the constitution and By-laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
