

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS: The Commissioner of Indian Affairs, with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, has, under date of April 13, 1939, suggested changes in the forms to be used in our tribal buying enterprise as established by resolution of the Tribal Council dated March 6, 1939 which changes have been designed to improve the structure of the enterprise now:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: By the Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe under authority of its Constitution and By-laws hereby amends its resolution of March 6, 1939 in order to incorporate therein the changes recommended in the above mentioned letter of April 12, 1939 signed by Mr. E. J. Armstrong for the Commissioner, a copy of which is attached hereto, which letter is made a part of this amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That, in order to expedite the functioning of the buying and selling enterprise, the Resolution of March 7, 1939 above referred to as hereby amended shall remain in full force and effect until a certified copy of copies of a duly adopted resolution or resolutions rescinding or further amending the resolution as it now stands shall have been furnished to the Secretary of the Interior.
