

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The Tribal Council believes that it is to the interest of the Tribe to permit and encourage reservation industrial projects and as timber assets manufactured into lumber in our own mill operated by our own people, provides labor for our people and the manufactured product and use in our housing program and lumber products for sale to other government projects and for commercial sale at a profit through which our mill will continue to be financed as a reservation industry.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 25th day of March recommend and approve the placing of a contract with the reliable, low bidder for cutting and delivering one million board feet more or less of logs to the Whiteriver Saw Mill, all in accordance with the present Forestry practice and supervised by forestry personnel under the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was this 25th day of March 1940 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
