

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS: Mr. Louis A. Kuehne has located manganese and other minerals on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation and has made proper location filing with the County Recorder of Gila County and the Fort Apache Indian Agency, and desires to develop the mining properties, has made application for mining lease on six claims totaling 120 acres.

AND WHEREAS: The Tribal Council believes that in the interest of promoting reservation industries, the applicant should be given an opportunity to carry on mining operations to develop revenues for the Tribe if any exist:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approve the lease of Mr. Louis A. Kuehne in accordance with the authority vested by Section 1 (c), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

The foregoing resolution was this 25th day of March, 1940, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
