

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation that participation in the Range Conservation Program under the Agricultural Adjustment Administration is desirable and has resulted in the construction of sixteen earthen tanks on reservation range lands, and

WHEREAS, these tanks which have been constructed at practically no cost to the Tribe will be of great value to the range lands and stock industry of the reservation by providing additional water facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approves the tank construction program as carried on under the Agricultural Adjustment Administration and upon approval of such construction by the AAA engineers and the county committee, hereby authorizes the Treasurer of the Tribal Council and/or the President and Secretary of any reservation Indian livestock association within whose districts tanks have been constructed, to assign any and all payments received from AAA for work approved by the AAA engineers and the county committee either directly to the contractor or to the Superintendent of the Reservation with the understanding that the amounts received and assigned shall be payment in full for all work performed as herein above outlined.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of July 1940, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 1 (a), Article VI of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
