

RESOLUTION

NO. 49

WHEREAS: This Reservation has been notified, through CCC-ID Office at Phoenix, Arizona, that additional funds for enrollee wages and subsistence may be available; provided, participating agencies may be able to furnish materials and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND RECOMMENDED: That Tribal funds be appropriated, on a basis of one dollar tribal money to each two dollars of CCC-ID money allotted for the following purposes:

1. Construction and improvement of Reservation truck-trails and bridges, and adjacent to outlying Indian Communities
2. Range improvements, including construction and improvement of water development projects and fence projects.

PROVIDED: That the location of the projects indicated above, and upon which tribal funds are to be expended, shall be determined by the Tribal Council. It is further provided that the Tribal Funds to be expended in truck-trail and bridge improvements not exceed \$15,000, and in Range improvements not exceed \$10,000.

The foregoing resolution was this 9th day of September 1940 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d) & (a), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
