

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council in Special session this 26th day of September, 1940, having duly considered the excess or surplus Tribal funds accumulating in the Tribal Individual Indian Money Account, and the advisability of depositing the surplus funds with the Treasurer of the United States as "Proceeds of Labor, Fort Apache Indians, Arizona," in order to derive interest on the account.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Tribal Council approve the transfer of One Hundred Fifty Thousand --(\$150,000.) Dollars, from the Tribal Individual Indian Money Account, to the Treasurer of the United States, for credit to the Tribal account "Proceeds of Labor, Fort Apache Indians, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency be requested and he is hereby authorized to effect the transfer of the funds in the amount above stated, from the Tribal Individual Indian Money Account, of the Fort Apache Agency, to Miscellaneous receipts, thereafter depositing funds in accordance with regulations.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1940 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
