R E S O L U T I O N

Be it resolved by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session at Whiteriver, Arizona, on December 2, 1940, that:

1. The Arizona State Game Commission or its authorized officers be permitted to trap not to exceed twenty-five (25) turkes for transplanting within the State.
2. The State Game Commission or its authorized officers agree to use the Verball Non-Mutilating traps, or traps used by the Biological Survey Department, in taking this game.

Therefore be it further resolved, that for the taking of twenty-five turkeys (25), the State Game Commission or its authorized officers in return will trap as many coyotes as possible in conjunction with predatory trapping operations.

The foregoing resolution was this 2d day of December 1940, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (p), Article VI of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
