

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special Session this 23rd day of June 1941; that:

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council in regular session on May 6, 1940, duly passed a resolution approving a mining lease on six contiguous claim containing approximately 120 acres of unallotted land, in favor of Louis A. Kuehne of Holbrook, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the action of the Tribal Council was approved by the Secretary of the Interior, under date of May 31, 1940, and

WHEREAS, Louis A. Kuehne, lessee, now desires to Assign his Lease, in accordance with the provisions of Section 26 (a) of the Rules Governing the leasing of Tribal Lands for Mining purposes", (25 U.S.C. 186.26 (a); and has executed an Assignment on the prescribed forms in favor of Messrs. A. L. Lampton and E. C. Voss, of Phoenix, Arizona under date of June 12, 1941, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council on May 17, 1941, in special session did pass a resolution approving the assignment of the aforesaid Lease to Mr. A. L. Lampton and Hollis B. Gray, and

WHEREAS, Said assignment has been withdrawn by mutual consent of the parties concerned, and prior to approval of the Secretary of the Interior,

NOWHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; by the Tribal Council that the Assignment of the Mining Lease from Louis A. Kuehne, to Messrs., A. L. Lampton and E. C. Voss be and is hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted this 23rd day of June, 1941 by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 1 (c), Article VI, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
