

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT SACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 12th day of January, 1942, that:

All funds collected at the Community Building through the efforts of the various civic organizations comprised of residents, federal and tribal employees of White River through their efforts for purely social, beneficial, charitable and relief purposes for the community and tribe where federal work hours are not involved, be expended by the various organizations as to them seems advisable.

Be it further resolved that during this time of emergency, when our country is at war and many of our Indian men are in the armed forces, insofar as possible, all net funds derived from pictures be expended for the support of such men and their immediate dependents, judiciously administered through a committee selected from the Council, community and employees, where such funds will do the most good.

Be it further resolved that all funds derived from the use of the Community Building for purely commercial purposes be deposited in the Individual Indian money account of the Tribe.

Be it further resolved that at the end of each fiscal year a complete statement of all receipts and expenditures be submitted to the Tribal Council for approval and tribal record.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1942 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) & (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
