

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 3d day of August, 1942, that:

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council under date of December 1, 1941, approved a Tribal Grazing Permit, numbered 17, for Bert J. Colter of Springerville, Arizona to hold and graze on tribal land of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for a period of three years beginning May 1, 1942 and terminating November 1, 1944, 950 head of cattle at an annual rate of \$1.50 per head, the annual grazing period being from May 1 to November 1, of each year, and

WHEREAS, Bert J. Colter has made formal request by letter under date of July 29, 1942 that he be permitted to transfer or assign his grazing permit to Mr. T. E. Reed of Holbrook, Arizona, owing to his inability and difficulty in getting help to work his stock and farm, and

WHEREAS, the present permittee, Mr. Bert J. Colter, recommends Mr. T. E. Reed as a dependable and reliable citizen, fully capable of carrying out the conditions and terms of the permit.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approve the request of Mr. Colter and hereby consent to the assignment of this permit to Mr. T. E. Reed as heretofore stated with a provision that the assignee furnish the consent of the bondsmen under the original permit or a properly executed bond as required by the grazing regulations.

The foregoing resolution was this 3d day of August, 1942, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (n), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984).
