

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date September 9, 1942, that:

WHEREAS, owing to the war, the road budget has been, of necessity, greatly reduced allowing only enough for limited maintenance for roads and trails already constructed and no road fund will be available for new construction, and

WHEREAS, there remains a very important section of two miles on Highway 12, being the main Whiteriver - Cibecue Road, taking off from Highway 60 and connecting with the completed portion this side of Cibecue Mountain which section is by far the poorest and hardest winter road to travel and at times isolates the Cibecue District, and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to find work for Indian Labor, which labor cannot leave the Reservation and seek employment outside, and

WHEREAS, road equipment is available to take on this work and the location is such that it will make it possible for both Cibecue and Corrizo Indians and do the work, and

WHEREAS, the road organization of the reservation is virtually intact.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary approve the expenditure of \$20,000 from the Individual Indian Mone-White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, of which there is in special deposit approximately \$100,000, and that the Superintendent be authorized to proceed with the construction of this two miles of road in accordance with plans and regulations previously carried on and approved by the Roads Department.

The foregoing resolution was this 9th day of September, 1942, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d & e), Article VI, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1935, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
