

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 5th day of April, 1943 that:

WHEREAS, it is within the powers of the Tribal Council to submit to the Department of the Interior, recommendations for the expenditures of gratuity and tribal funds for tribal support, reservation improvements and other necessary activities looking toward the advancement of the members of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, in addition to the benefits which the Tribe received during the calendar year 1942 from its tribally-owned ID cattle, known as the Old Folks' Herd arising from the issue of 257 yearling bulls to the district stock associations and from the sale, on credit, of 407 yearling heifers to young Indians - thereby enabling them to share in the grazing resources of the Reservation - there was an actual cash income from the sale of surplus ID cattle amounting to \$44,167.86 which was deposited to Individual Indian Money, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, Old Folks' Herd, and

WHEREAS, there has been prepared an Advanced Estimate of proposed expenditures needed for the operation of our Old Folks' Herd, consisting of some 2517 head of cattle, which has been carefully examined and considered in regard to the actual needs of the Reservation insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance and composed of the following sums:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve and the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends and approves the above estimate for the Fiscal Year as herewith presented.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1943, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
