

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date September 6, 1943, that

WHEREAS, the Tribe has on deposit in its Individual Indian Money Account approximately \$77,500.00, which fund is not needed at the present time for tribal purposes, and

WHEREAS, this is not at present an interest bearing fund and money is needed by the Federal Government for defense purposes, and the tribe is anxious to cooperate with the Federal Government in defense measures,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs and the Secretary of the Interior approve the purchase for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, \$50,000 of Series G United States Savings Bonds, registered in the name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 6, 1943 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 948).
