

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 1st day of March, 1943,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council under date of December 1, 1941 approved a Tribal Grazing Permit, Numbered 17, for Bert J. Colter of Springerville, Arizona to hold and graze on tribal land of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for a period of three years beginning May 1, 1942 and terminating December 1, 1944, 250 head of cattle at an annual rate of \$1.50 per head, the annual grazing period being from May 1 to November 1 of each year, and

AND WHEREAS, Bert J. Colter has made formal request by letter under date of February 26, 1943 that he be permitted to transfer or assign all but the following described portion of this permit to Mr. T. E. Reed, Holbrook, Arizona, for the remainder of the duration of the Permit, owing to his inability and difficulty in getting help to work his stock grazed on the permit. A description of the portion of the range under the above permit to be retained is as follows:

Beginning at the junction of the Springerville Road with the Reservation boundary; thence in a southwesterly direction on the south side of the Springerville Road, approximately two miles; thence south to Snake Creek where it joins the Phelps pasture fence; thence south approximately 2½ miles toward Mount Baldy; thence east to the Reservation fence; thence north along the reservation fence to point of beginning; the total area to be retained is approximately 6,400 acres and commonly known as the Phelps Pasture and adjoining heifer pasture.

The area in Range Unit No. 13 relinquished to T. E. Reed, will constitute all that portion of Unit No. 13 except the area described above, which covers a total area of approximately 13,110, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council approves the request of Mr. Colter and hereby consents to the assignment of the above mentioned portion of the permit to Mr. Reed as hereinafter stated with the provision that the assignee furnish the consent of the bondsmen under the original permit or properly executed bond as required by the grazing regulations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that approval granted in Council Resolution No. 90 under date of August 3, 1942, is hereby cancelled.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of March, 1943, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (n), Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the
