RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
in regular session this date May 1, 1944, that:

The recommendation by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs that
stumpage prices on the Hop Canyon Unit, under contract to the
Peterson Lumber Mill of Pinedale, Arizona, be increased from
\$3.05 per M for all species to \$3.35 per M for all species as
of June 1, 1944, be approved by the Council of the White Mountain
Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of May, 1944 duly adopted
by a vote of 1 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the
White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by
Section 1 (d), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,
ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 12, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
