

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The grazing leases to the permittees on the reservation will expire this fall and next spring, and it is necessary to advertise several months in advance, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to derive revenues for the tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: By the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this \_\_\_\_\_ day of December, 1944 that the Superintendent may advertise and lease Range Unit No. 1, 2, 10, 13, 13a and 16 for a three-year period on condition that the No. 1 and No. 2 be modified as follows:

Range Unit No. 1:

That the permittee on No. 1 keep within the original boundary and intent of these boundaries; namely, starting of the point half-way between Bull Flat Canyon and Cow Creek, thence in northeastern direction to the Chediski Road. (This means the road leading to Chediski Tower from the north, which is the main tribal road from the north boundary of the Reservation to the Chediski Tower). Then north to the north boundary and around to the point of beginning. That any fences constructed and range taken in outside of this boundary be removed.

Range Unit No. 2:

That the portion of Range No. 2 from the north boundary thereof near Red Lake and down to Gentry Mountain and east to Canyon Creek be returned to the tribe for Indian use.

With the above modifications, grazing privilege shall be awarded to the highest bidder, that the previous permittee shall be given the privilege of meeting the high bid on his Unit.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 4, 1944 duly adopted by vote of \_\_\_\_\_ for, and \_\_\_\_\_ against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1936 pursuant to Section 13 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
