

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. of McNary, Arizona, as Purchaser, has timber contracts on the Smith Park-Horse Mesa, North Fork and Maverick Units of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, The Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., having failed to meet contractual minimum cutting requirements for the contract logging year ending March 31, 1945 on all the above Units, has, by letter of February 5, 1945, requested relief from said contractual minimum cutting requirements and paying requirements,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 8th day of February, 1945 that the request of the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc. for relief from minimum cutting and paying requirements, as indicated in the contracts of the Smith Park-Horse Mesa, North Fork and Maverick Units for the contract logging year ending March 31, 1945, be given favorable consideration by the Secretary of the Interior.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1945 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
