

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITEMOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in  
regular session this 9/4/46 that,

An allotment from Individual Indian Moneys, in the amount of \$1,000  
be made for the purpose of supplying additional funds for Forest  
Fire suppression activities within the Whitemountain Indian Reservation.  
Reasons being that this has been a very hard and serious fire season  
and funds regularly allotted have not been sufficient to pay all the  
Indian labor necessary to control the fires.

The foregoing resolution was this 4 th day of Sept. 1946 duly adopted  
by a vote of for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the  
~~Whitemountain~~ Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section  
I (d). Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified  
ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary  
of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
