

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, we are still having trouble with predatory animals such as lions, bears, wolves, coyotes, bobcats, coons, etc.; and the livestock and turkey losses are still considerable, it is the wish of the Council that we continue to eradicate these animals from the reservation by the payment of a bounty and otherwise:

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Council request the Secretary of the Interior to approve the expenditure of additional \$4,000 to be expended as follows:

Lions - - - - -	\$30.00	per head
Cub Lions - - - - -	20.00	per head
Old bears - - - - -	25.00	per head
Cub bears - - - - -	10.00	per head
Wolves - - - - -	10.00	per head
Coyotes - - - - -	5.00	per head
Bobcats - - - - -	5.00	per head
Coons - - - - -	3.00	per head
Porcupine - - - - -	3.00	per head

The foregoing Resolution has this date been duly adopted by a vote 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
