

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this day of May, 1946, that:

Whereas: it is within the powers of the Tribal Council to recommend expenditure of Tribal funds for activities having to do with the support and advancement of the Tribe and its members, and

Whereas: the 1946 budget previously approved, for the operation of the Old Folks Herd has proven inadequate, the estimated expenses for the balance of the year being \$10,110. while the balance in the account is only \$4,909.05 leaving an estimated deficiency of \$5200.95;

Be it resolved and recommended that funds be made available for the following expenses for the Old Folks Herd for the balance of the fiscal year of 1945.

Range cubes-----	\$2100.00
Groceries-----	300.00
Labor and General Expense-----	3500.00
Fence between Turkey Creek & I. D. ranges-----	600.00
Laboratory supplies-----	50.00
Saddle horse to replace one killed by lightning-----	100.00
Seed oats, gasoline, labor, balingwire, machinery repairs and other costs of growing feed for I. D. stock-----	1460.00
Hay-----	400.00
Pick-up baler & side delivery rake-----	<u>1600.00</u>
Total Est. Expense-----	\$10110.00
Balance on hand-----	\$4909.05
Additional amount needed-----	\$5200.95

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted this 6th day of May, 1946 by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-Laws, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on August 28, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
