

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May, 1946 that;

WHEREAS, several years ago some living quarters were constructed by the tribe for use of Indians employed by the Southwest Lumber Company which are now in need of certain repairs and painting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$500 of funds now on deposit with Fort Apache Agency be made available for such needed repairs.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 6th, 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article 6, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
