

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May 1946 that;

WHEREAS, the mining lease of Gladys Baker and Charles Ireland dated May 17, 1941 has not produced any asbestos ore of consequence and,

WHEREAS, the Globe Asbestos Company has agreed to pay the White Mountain Apache Tribe a royalty of \$2.75 per ton of ore mined,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the assignment of the lease held by Gladys Baker and Charles Ireland to the Globe Asbestos Company, is hereby approved subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the clause in the original mining lease, granted Gladys Baker and Charles Ireland, providing for royalty payments be amended to provide for royalty payments at the rate of \$2.75 per ton. Such royalty payments to be subject to revision when in the opinion of the Superintendent studies of mining and milling of the asbestos ore may justify such revision.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on May 6th, 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 16, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
