

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May 1946 that;

WHEREAS, the Indians of the communities of McNary, Whiteriver, East Park and Canyon Day have organized among themselves, a baseball team and,

WHEREAS, it is believed that such activities are worthwhile for the Indians and should be encouraged and,

WHEREAS, these communities are not financially able to furnish needed equipment for these baseball teams.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that expenditures not exceeding \$100 for each of the above named baseball teams is hereby approved and authorized; such expenditures to be made available from funds now on deposit to the credit of the tribe, Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 6th, 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article 6, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
