

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 6th day of May 1946 that;

WHEREAS, the Globe Asbestos Company of Globe, Arizona, has applied for a lease of certain tribal lands for the purpose of mining asbestos ore located adjacent to the lease of Gladys Eaker and Charles Ireland and,

WHEREAS, the Globe Asbestos Company appears to be in a position to properly develop and work such a mine.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the lease of sixty acres of tribal land for mining asbestos ore by the Globe Asbestos Company is hereby approved, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on May 6th 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that encouragement to obtain higher education by the members of the tribe should be given, and

WHEREAS, Eugene V. Ethelbah has requested a loan of \$240 to assist him in getting started in college, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council does hereby approve the request of Eugene Ethelbah for a loan of \$240 for educational purposes providing that reasonable security is offered and that the applicant will sign a promissory note agreeing to repayment of the loan within two years.

The foregoing Resolution was this 3rd day of June, 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d) Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
