

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular meeting assembled this 3rd day of June 1946 that funds be made available for certain range improvement work, and

WHEREAS there is need for clearing of stock driveways to assist in moving cattle from one area to another and for the construction of holding pastures, stock traps and other range improvements to provide better facilities for taking care of livestock on the mountain ranges, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that \$10,000 of funds now on deposit in an Individual Indian Money Account with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the tribe be made available for clearing of stock driveways, construction of holding pastures and other range improvements.

The foregoing Resolution was this 3rd day of June, 1946, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d) Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
