

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache tribe, that,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that a certain amount of credit is necessary for the Indians of the Fort Apache Reservation in order to assist Indian Veterans and other worthy Indians in improving their homes in obtaining livestock, farm implements and other necessary items and desires to make it possible for members of the tribe to obtain loans under certain conditions,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation in regular meeting assembled this first day of July, 1946, a quorum being present, that the amount of \$20,000 of tribal funds on deposit in IIM Account of the Fort Apache Agency are hereby authorized for revolving credit purposes for loans to members of the tribe for rehabilitation use, provided that loans shall be made in accordance with Revolving Credit Regulations, and provided further that no loan shall be made in excess of \$1,000 to one individual or shall a loan be granted in any amount that will cause the borrower to be indebted to the tribe or the Government in excess of \$1,000,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a loan Committee consisting of three members of the Tribal Council shall be appointed by the Council to approve all loan applications submitted in accordance with this resolution and the chairman of such loan committee is hereby authorized to sign such loan applications for the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was this first day of July, 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (e) Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
