

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Riley Way, a member of the Tribe, is hereby granted an assignment of land described as follows:

Lot.1, Block 1 of Indian Homes Addition, Whiteriver, Arizona, said lot being approximately 100 feet wide in front, 200 feet deep, and 75 feet wide in the rear facing the adjacent street.

Said assignment shall grant to Riley Way, the assignee, the full and exclusive right to occupy said land for homesite purposes only. It is expressly stipulated herein that in the event the said Riley Way shall desire to dispose of any buildings that may be erected on said land that said transfer shall be to a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe only except as otherwise provided herein, and then with the consent of the Council. In the event the assignee desires to sell or transfer said buildings or other improvements to any person, firm, company or association not a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, then the said transfer or sale shall be subject to the approval of the Council, and any such transfer of buildings or improvements shall not convey any title to said lands so occupied.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on July 29, 1946, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(b) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
