

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in session this 29th day of July 1946, that:

WHEREAS, the Church Building on the campus of Theodore Roosevelt School designated as Building No. 106 has never been used by the Apache Indians and has no particular significance to the Apache people and is of no use to the school,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that no objections are interposed to the proposal to have this building removed from the campus of the Theodore Roosevelt School in order to make room for enlarged athletic facilities.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe this 29th day of July 1945 by a vote of 7 for and 0 against.
