

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Fish and Wildlife Service, the Indian Service and the Arizona State Fish and Game Commission have proposed an agreement providing for the operation of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery at McNary, Arizona, located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, now

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that said agreement providing for the cooperative operation of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery, McNary, Arizona, is hereby approved provided that contributions of funds from sources other than Federal shall not accord the contributor any right, title or interest in and to the lands, waters, property, or other facilities of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe this 9th day of September, 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
