

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the grazing permit issued to Tom Reed, Holbrook, Arizona, for grazing privileges on range unit No. 13 for the period January 1, 1945 to December 31, 1947, was cancelled at the close of 1945 grazing season in order for the range to be available for Indian-owned cattle, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular meeting this 4th day of November 1946, a quorum being present, that the sum of \$1000 be paid Mr. Tom Reed for range improvements constructed on said range unit by the permittee at no cost to the tribe or the government. Said payment to constitute full and complete payment for all improvements so constructed, and title to said improvements shall hereafter rest with the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on November 4, 1946, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the constitution and B-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
