

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
PORT APACHE RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that the Chief Judge of the Tribal Court shall hereafter be authorized to take leave with pay not exceeding 26 working days per year. The Judge shall be required to submit written request for leave to the Superintendent for record purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted on January 6, 1947, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(g) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
