

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, There is need of improvements to various irrigation canals, structures and other irrigation works for which funds are not available.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2,000 from available tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency for use on the improvement and repair of irrigation canals, Flumes, gates and other irrigation structures to improve the existing irrigation systems serving Indian farm and garden lands. Said funds to be used in connection with other applicable funds for irrigation purposes and to remain available until expended.

The foregoing resolution was, on February 17, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
