

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal Funds on deposit in an I.L.M. Account at the Fort Apache Agency the sum of \$2000 for operation, repair and upkeep of the tribally owned tractors, said tractors to be used to assist Indian farmers in plowing and other work, provided that when said tractors are used for individual Indians that a fee of \$1.00 per hour shall be charged and all receipts for the use of said tractors shall be deposited to the credit of the "Tractor Operation Fund".

The foregoing resolution was, this 3rd day of March, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (d) Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
