

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, A. E. Halstead, as purchaser, (by assignment) has a timber contract on the Red Lake Unit of the Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the contract on the Red Lake Unit has not been completed, and

WHEREAS, the said contract on the Red Lake Unit expired as of March 31, 1947,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of April, 1947, approves extension of said contract, covering the Red Lake Unit, from March 31, 1937 to March 31, 1948.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 7th, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
