

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Police of the Fort Apache Agency do not have adequate transportation facilities necessary.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the purchase of a 1/2 ton panel pickup truck for use of the police is hereby authorized and that payment therefore be made from tribal funds on deposit with Fort Apache Agency, provided the cost of said truck does not exceed \$1300.00.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1947 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 948).
