

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Tribe that whereas the Arizona State Highway Department desires to reconstruct a portion of State Highway 173 and State Highway 73 (Non-FAS-Project 16) from the north boundary of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to point near the town of McNary, Arizona, within the reservation that, consent of the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a right-of-way for said road project in accordance with right-of-way map submitted is hereby granted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this approval is granted with the provisions that no trees except within the construction area of the highway shall be cut, removed, or damaged, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arizona State Highway Department is authorized to take mineral aggregate required for construction of Non-FAS Project 16 only from designated lands outside of said right-of-way without compensation to the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was this 5th day of May, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 (a) Article VI of the Constitution and B-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.).
