

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 5th day of May, 1947, that;

WHEREAS, an advanced estimate of proposed expenditures for the Tribal Old Folks Herd for the fiscal year, 1948, has been prepared after careful consideration of past necessary expenses and needs for the coming year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve the following budget for the operation of the Old Folks Herd for the fiscal year 1948.

Labor and Horse Hire	\$ 12,900.00
Feeds (Hay, Cane & Grain)	8,000.00
Groceries	600.00
Fence Repair	2,000.00
Fuel and Oil	400.00
Auto and Trucking Expenses	900.00
Vet. and Artificial Breed. Supplies	500.00
Miscellaneous	200.00
	<u>\$ 25,500.00</u>

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 5th, 1947, by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
